## A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2018 PERTAINING TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ELM STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF HOOSICK FALLS

### Section 1. Purpose and Authority.

The purpose of this local law is to amend Local Law No. 1 of 2018 pertaining to parking restrictions on and along certain sections of Elm Street in the Village of Hoosick in accordance with the authority granted to the Village Board of Trustees under Section 1640(a)(6) of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.

### Section 2. Parking Restrictions.

Section 2 of Local Law No. 1 of 2018 is hereby rescinded and replaced in its entirety as follows:

The parking of vehicles is prohibited in the locations described below for a longer period of time than that designated, during the hours indicated, on any days:
