

Village of Hoosick Falls - June 17th, 2024

VILLAGE ANNOUNCES A 3-WEEK CHANGE IN AVAILABILITY OF WATER WORKS ROAD & THE SOUTHERN END OF THE GREENWAY; Hoosic River Greenway to remain fully walkable throughout the process.

The Village of Hoosick Falls is announcing a change in the availability of the southern end of the Greenway and the southern end of Waterworks Road, running from 6/18 to 7/5, due to construction of the new waterline. Extra efforts have been made to make sure that the Greenway remains accessible and walkable from all directions.

There is a 3-week long scope of work that requires construction vehicles, equipment, and supplies to be stationed and used at the end of Waterworks Road and the southern end of the Greenway. Because of this important work, the availability of vehicular traffic will change as follows:

Week 1 - 6/17 to 6/23: Most of Waterworks Road will remain accessible, except for the very last stretch past the Water Treatment Plant. No thru traffic or parking will be allowed in this area during this time.

Week 2 & 3 - 6/24 to 7/5: The restricted area will increase in size, meaning that no vehicular traffic will be allowed past the old (2nd) Highway Garage/past the final baseball/softball field. The contractors anticipate opening the area by the end of the day, July 5th.

The Hoosic River Greenway will remain accessible throughout the entire process, but with a slight diversion at the Southern end. A temporary path has been made that cuts across the youth football field and uses a new ramp (please use caution on this stone ramp. Bikers should consider walking your bike down this ramp - see pictures for more information (see attached pictures).

Parking for the Greenway will be available along the open parts of Waterworks Road and across from the new Highway Garage where the dog park is located. When Weeks 2 & 3 of the work commence, there will still be a walkable path, likely behind the guardrails in the grass.

We apologize for the inconvenience. As a reminder, this 3-week scope of work is part of the larger initiative to bring a new water source to the Village of Hoosick Falls.



The southern end of the Hoosic River Greenway is currently blocked off by construction equipment. It will remain inaccessible through July 5th, 2024.
